Detailed Reviewer's Report

The paper proposes a new concept—**Pressure-to-Trust Governance**—that integrates governance across crisis management, infrastructure, technology, compliance, public administration, and safety systems. This interdisciplinary approach is interesting and potentially valuable.

Suggestions

1. Conduct a case study in one or more organizations.
2. Develop and validate the Pressure-to-Trust Governance Index.
3. Include interviews or survey data.
4. Add a comparison with existing governance frameworks.
5. Reduce reliance on self-citations where possible.
6. Improve operational definitions and measurement details.
7. Refine formatting of figures and tables.

Final Verdict

This manuscript presents a **promising and original conceptual governance framework** with strong practical relevance. Its biggest limitation is the **absence of empirical validation** and a more rigorous methodological foundation. Addressing these issues would substantially strengthen its impact.
