- The methodology of the paper needs to be explained and the parameters of selection need to be highlight.
- The methodology should also state the papramenters of how the interviewees are selected.
- There are majorgrammatical errors in the paper which needs to be corrected.

- The conclusion and discussion sections needs to be separated. The discussion or analysis of the result section should be included in more of a matrix or tabular format before the conclusion part where the author highlights and mentions the major findings and their implications.
- The methodology of the paper needs to be more descriptive and elaborative where the selected parameters need to be detailed out a bit more. And also should include how they were observed and monitored for this study. The interviews conducted should also highlight the parameters how they were selected also the matrix data included in the analysis section should mention the parameters of the data selected.
- The paper needs to be as per the journal's guidelines and format should be followed. The references should be increased.
