Detailed Reviewer's Report

The methodology section would benefit from additional detail, especially regarding data collection methods, sample size (if applicable), and analytical techniques used. Furthermore, formatting inconsistencies such as spacing, alignment, and referencing style should be corrected to meet journal standards.

Overall, the paper presents valuable insights and makes a meaningful contribution to the field, but minor revisions in language, clarity, and formatting are necessary before it can be considered for publication.
