### *Detailed Reviewer's Report*

#### **Strength of the study**

- Focuses on a clinically relevant orthodontic problem affecting aesthetics and function
- Clear case presentation with detailed diagnosis and treatment planning
- Use of CBCT for accurate localization improves diagnostic reliability
- Stepwise treatment procedure is well explained
- Good use of pre and post treatment records including cephalometric data
- Demonstrates successful interdisciplinary management

#### **Weakness of the study**

- Single case report limits generalizability of findings
- Some inconsistencies in diagnosis description between sections
- Language and grammar need minor improvement
- Limited discussion comparing with previous literature
- No long term follow up mentioned
- Figures are present but not described in sufficient detail

#### **Reviewers Comments**

This manuscript presents a well documented case report on the management of an impacted maxillary central incisor using a combined surgical and orthodontic approach. The case is clearly described, and the use of CBCT and cephalometric analysis, as shown on pages 2 and 6, strengthens the diagnostic aspect. The treatment steps are logical and the final outcome appears satisfactory with good aesthetic and functional improvement. Ethical aspects are appropriately addressed through patient consent, which is clearly mentioned. However, the manuscript requires minor improvement in grammar and sentence clarity. There is some inconsistency in diagnosis description that should be corrected. The discussion section could be expanded with more comparison to existing studies. Being a single case report, the findings have limited applicability, and lack of long term follow up is a limitation. Overall, it is a clinically useful report with minor revisions needed.
