Strengths:

Major Concerns:

- The study does not include empirical evidence or case-based analysis to substantiate its theoretical arguments.
- The discussion is highly abstract and dense, which may reduce clarity and reader engagement.
- The research gap and the paper's specific contributions are not clearly articulated.
- Certain ideas are reiterated across multiple sections, leading to redundancy.

Minor Concerns:

- There are minor issues related to grammar and formatting.
- Citation style is inconsistent in some parts of the manuscript.
- Tables could be refined or simplified to improve clarity and readability.
