### *Detailed Reviewer's Report*

#### Strength of the study:

- Addresses an important clinical issue related to postoperative recovery after laminectomy
- Uses a quasi experimental design with study and control groups
- Includes multiple outcome measures covering physical and psychological aspects
- Ethical approval was obtained before data collection
- Reliability and validity of tools were assessed
- Follow up evaluation was conducted to assess sustainability of outcomes
- Findings have practical implications for nursing care and patient education

#### Weakness of the study:

- Sample size was relatively small and limited to a single center
- Non random sampling may introduce selection bias
- Some methodological details require clearer explanation
- Several grammatical and language errors are present throughout the manuscript
- Statistical reporting needs better consistency in some sections
- Follow up duration was relatively short
- Generalizability of findings to wider populations may be limited

#### Reviewers Comments:

This manuscript investigates the effect of an educational program on clinical outcomes among patients undergoing laminectomy and addresses a clinically relevant topic. The study design is appropriate for the stated objectives, and the inclusion of both physical and psychological outcome measures strengthens the work. Ethical clearance was clearly obtained, and patient confidentiality and voluntary participation were addressed adequately. The results indicate positive effects of the educational intervention on knowledge, disability, pain, psychological status, and social functioning. However, the manuscript requires language editing as grammatical errors, sentence construction issues, and formatting inconsistencies are present in several sections. The methodology is generally acceptable, although more details regarding intervention delivery and follow up procedures would improve clarity. Limitations related to sample size, single center recruitment, and non random sampling should be discussed more thoroughly. Overall, the study provides useful findings and contributes to nursing practice, but revisions are necessary before publication.
