Reviewer's Comment for Publication.

This study evaluated colonoscopy findings in 120 patients with lower gastrointestinal symptoms such as rectal bleeding, diarrhea, constipation, and weight loss. It shows that colonoscopy is a useful and safe method for diagnosing colorectal diseases.

Strength:

1. Important and clinically relevant topic.
2. Good sample size (120 patients).
3. Clear objectives and well-organized results.
4. Includes both colonoscopy and histopathology findings.
5. Supports the role of colonoscopy in early diagnosis.

Weakness:

1. Ethical approval and informed consent details are missing.
2. Only descriptive statistics were used; no advanced statistical analysis.
3. Discussion mainly repeats results instead of explaining their significance.
4. Histopathology was performed in only a limited number of patients.
5. Funding and conflict of interest statements are missing.

Overall assessment:

The study is useful and clinically relevant, but it requires major revisions in methodology reporting, statistical analysis, and manuscript formatting before it can be considered for publication.

Recommendation: Manuscript accepted for publication after minor revision.
