## Detailed Reviewer's Report

### Overall Evaluation

The manuscript addresses an important and timely topic by examining the contribution of humanitarian interventions to community resilience and socio-economic stability in Baidoa, Somalia. The study is relevant to humanitarian studies, development policy, and post-conflict recovery, particularly within fragile and conflict-affected contexts. The manuscript presents a logical structure with a clear introduction, literature review, theoretical background, methodology, findings, conclusion, and recommendations. The discussion highlights the importance of integrating humanitarian assistance with long-term development strategies and provides practical policy recommendations. The conclusions are generally supported by the findings presented. However, the manuscript relies primarily on qualitative evidence based on field experience, observations, interviews, and policy documents. While this approach provides valuable practical insights, stronger methodological details regarding participant selection, sample size, data validation, ethical considerations, and thematic coding procedures would further strengthen the academic rigor of the study. Overall, the manuscript makes a meaningful contribution to the existing literature on humanitarian interventions and resilience-building and is suitable for publication after minor revisions.

### Strengths

- The research focuses on a highly relevant humanitarian and development issue in Somalia, making it valuable for both academics and practitioners.
- The objectives are clearly stated and consistently addressed throughout the manuscript.

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- The literature review adequately discusses the humanitarian-development nexus and community resilience concepts.
- Appropriate theoretical frameworks are incorporated to support the research objectives.
- The findings provide practical insights drawn from field experience and humanitarian practice.
- The recommendations are realistic, policy-oriented, and directly linked to the study findings.
- The manuscript follows a logical organization with smooth transitions between sections.
- The language is generally clear, professional, and easy to understand.
- Recent references (2022–2024) enhance the relevance of the study.
- The conclusion effectively summarizes the major findings and policy implications.

### Areas for Improvement

- The methodology section should provide additional details regarding the number of participants, sampling strategy, interview procedures, and measures taken to ensure reliability and validity.
- Ethical approval and informed consent procedures should be explicitly mentioned.
- More detailed explanation of the thematic analysis process would improve methodological transparency.
- Some findings could be strengthened by incorporating direct participant quotations or illustrative examples from interviews.
- Minor grammatical and formatting inconsistencies should be corrected during proofreading.
