### Reviewer's Comment for Publication.

The manuscript addresses an important public health issue by evaluating severe anemia in pregnancy and its fetomaternal outcomes in a tertiary care setting. The study includes a reasonably large number of deliveries and provides useful clinical observations regarding socio-demographic factors, antenatal care, maternal complications, and neonatal outcomes. The topic is relevant and contributes to the understanding of severe anemia among pregnant women in resource-limited settings.

However, the manuscript requires **minor revision** before publication. The authors should improve the language and grammar throughout the manuscript to enhance readability. Several references contain formatting errors such as "Error! Bookmark not defined," which must be corrected. The methodology should be described more clearly, including details of statistical analysis, ethical approval, and informed consent. The discussion would benefit from a more critical comparison of the findings with recent published literature. In addition, the manuscript should clearly state its limitations and strengthen the conclusion by highlighting the clinical implications of the findings.

Overall, the study has scientific merit and practical relevance. After addressing the above editorial and presentation issues, the manuscript would be suitable for publication.
