Reviewer's Comment for Publication.

Strength:

1. Clinically important and educational case involving complex nasal reconstruction.
2. Surgical technique is described clearly with good intraoperative and postoperative photographs.
3. Discussion is supported by current literature and relevant guidelines.
4. Highlights successful reconstruction in an elderly patient, emphasizing that age alone should not limit surgical management.

1. Follow-up period is short (<30 days), preventing long-term assessment.
2. Functional outcomes and patient satisfaction are not reported.
3. Details regarding flap staging and pedicle division require further clarification.
4. Single case report limits generalizability of the findings.
5. Minor language and formatting corrections are recommended.

The manuscript presents a valuable surgical case demonstrating successful reconstruction of a large nasal defect using combined locoregional flaps after basal cell carcinoma excision. The case contributes useful clinical experience and is supported by an appropriate literature review. Minor revisions addressing
