Reviewer's Comment for Publication.

This study evaluated the effect of comprehensive nursing intervention on gastrointestinal complications in critically ill patients receiving intermittent enteral feeding. A quasi-experimental study was conducted on 160 patients (80 study and 80 control). The results showed that comprehensive nursing intervention significantly reduced gastric residual volume, abdominal distension, vomiting, diarrhea, and constipation, leading to better patient outcomes compared with routine care.

Strength:

1. The study addresses an important clinical nursing issue.
2. Adequate sample size with study and control groups.
3. Clear objectives, methodology, and intervention.
4. Appropriate statistical analysis with significant findings.
5. Practical recommendations for improving nursing practice.

Weakness:

1. The manuscript contains numerous grammatical and language errors.
2. The intervention protocol is described in excessive detail and should be condensed.
3. Randomization was not fully applied, increasing the possibility of selection bias.
4. Conducted at a single hospital, limiting generalizability.
5. The discussion is lengthy and repetitive.

Overall assessment:

The manuscript presents clinically relevant findings and demonstrates that comprehensive nursing intervention effectively reduces gastrointestinal complications in critically ill patients receiving intermittent enteral feeding. However, minor language editing and improvement in manuscript presentation are required before publication.
