Detailed Reviewer's Report

The manuscript addresses a relevant nursing topic, but major methodological and reporting issues need correction before publication.

- Study design is inconsistent: the manuscript reports both true experimental and quasi-experimental designs.
- Sampling method is inconsistent: purposive sampling and probability sampling are reported in different sections.
- Major outcome gap: the title/objectives include knowledge and practice, but the presented results primarily report knowledge. Practice findings are missing.
- Statistical analysis needs revision: paired *t*-tests alone do not establish intervention effectiveness; a proper between-group comparison/change-score analysis or ANCOVA is needed.
- Table 5 requires verification: the overall mean scores (4/30 and 7/30) do not correspond to the reported 40% and 70%.
- Tool validation is inadequately reported: item structure, scoring, validity and reliability coefficients should be clearly presented.
- Intervention details are insufficient for replication, including session duration, number and content.
- References require independent verification for accuracy and authenticity.
- Discussion largely repeats the results and needs stronger comparison with previous evidence.

Recommendation: Major Revision. The study has potential, but the methodological inconsistencies and missing practice data must be resolved before it can be considered scientifically robust.
