Detailed Reviewer's Report

Strength of the study:

- Rare and clinically important case
- Clear presentation of the clinical history
- Relevant use of serial β hCG monitoring
- Doppler ultrasound findings are well described
- Conservative management was clearly explained
- Discussion highlights an important diagnostic dilemma
- References are generally relevant
- The case has practical clinical value

Weakness of the study:

- Only a single case is reported
- Follow up duration is not clearly stated
- Ethical approval or patient consent is not mentioned
- More clinical and laboratory details could be provided
- The imaging description could be more detailed
- Differential diagnosis could be discussed more clearly
- Some references are duplicated
- Grammar and formatting need minor correction

Reviewers Comments:

This case report describes a rare and clinically relevant uterine arteriovenous malformation following treatment of gestational trophoblastic neoplasia. The clinical course is presented clearly, and the combination of normalized β hCG and Doppler findings supports the diagnosis and conservative approach. The topic is useful because UAVM can be mistaken for persistent trophoblastic disease and inappropriate uterine intervention may cause severe bleeding. The manuscript would benefit from providing clearer details about the duration and findings of follow up. Ethical clearance and written informed consent from the patient for publication should be clearly stated. The discussion is relevant but could be shortened in some areas and focused more on the specific learning point of the case. Grammar, sentence structure, spacing and reference formatting require careful proofreading. There is also duplication of one reference in the reference list. Overall, the case is interesting and has clinical value, but minor corrections are needed before publication.

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Previously Published anywhere/Plagiarism check:

The case appears to be presented as an original report, and no clear evidence of duplicate publication is apparent from the manuscript. The authors cite previous literature on uterine arteriovenous malformation and gestational trophoblastic disease appropriately. However, a formal plagiarism and similarity check should be completed before publication, and the authors should confirm that this particular case has not been reported previously.
