Detailed Reviewer's Report

Overall Evaluation

The paper addresses an important issue of student entrepreneurship and socio-professional integration. The mixed-method approach and sample of 285 students provide useful findings. However, the methodology, statistical analysis, and interpretation need improvement. Some claims appear stronger than the data supports.

Strengths

- Relevant and socially important topic.
- Clear focus on institutional, personal, and socio-economic factors.
- Uses both quantitative and qualitative methods.
- Provides useful findings on training, incubation, financing, and self-confidence.
- Gender differences are considered.
- Practical recommendations are provided.

Areas for Improvement

- Clearly explain the research gap and conceptual framework.
- Provide more details on sampling and questionnaire validation.
- Define and measure "socio-professional integration" clearly.
- Improve statistical analysis and avoid causal claims from descriptive data.
- Clarify inconsistent percentages, especially regarding financing.
- Strengthen the analysis of gender differences.

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- Improve the presentation of qualitative findings.
- Revise language, references, and overall academic presentation.
